

# 11 TOILET BOWL CLEANER

## PRO CHARGE TOILET CLEANER

### DESCRIPTION

PRO CHARGE TOILET BOWL CLEANER is a concentrated toilet and urinal cleaner which quickly removes rust, scale and uric acid deposits. Its unique formula does not produce fumes like some cleaners and is safe to use on stainless steel. Toilet bowl cleaner is a commercial grade disinfectant when used undiluted. The bowl cleaner is a purple viscous liquid with a floral fragrance.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For best results, use the toilet bowl cleaner neat in a squeeze bottle. If using daily, Pro charge toilet cleaner may be diluted up to 1:6 (100ml/600ml spray bottle). As a Commercial Grade Disinfectant: Use undiluted. Apply the toilet bowl cleaner to the bowl or urinal from a squeeze bottle if neat, or spray bottle if diluted. Ensure the sprayer is not adjusted to a fine mist. Use a brush to ensure the solution covers the entire surface. For heavy stains, allow solution to contact for up to 2 minutes. Flush the toilet/urinal and wipe off any Residue from around the top of the bowl/urinal or on the seat.

DO NOT MIX WITH ANY OTHER CHEMICALS.

### SAFETY INFORMATION

### FIRST AID

- SKIN If skin or hair contact occurs, flush thoroughly with running water. Remove contaminated clothing. If irritation occurs, get medical attention.

- INHALED Remove to fresh air. If you feel unwell, get medical attention

FIRST AID FACILITIES Eye wash station and normal washroom facilities.
